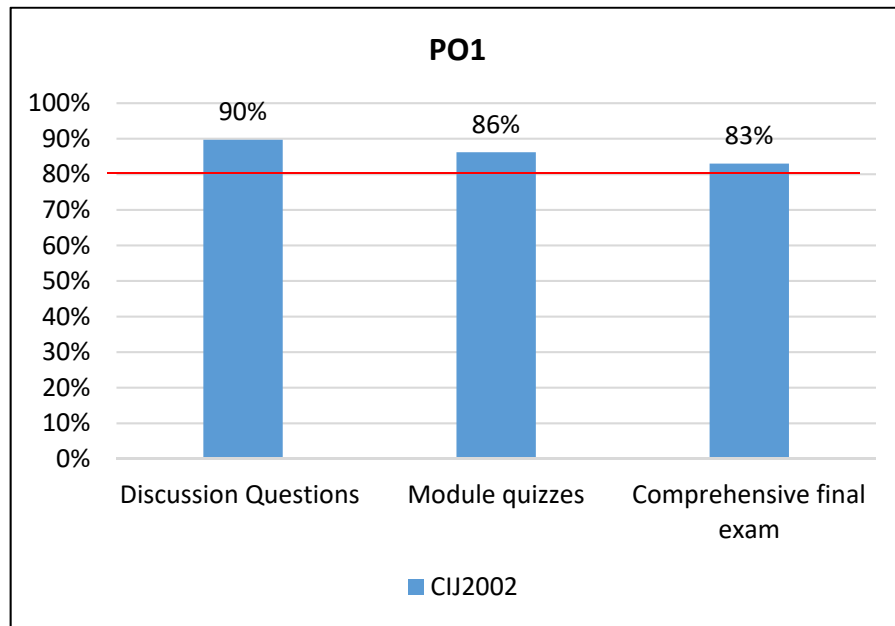


Exhibit effective communication within the field of Criminal Justice.

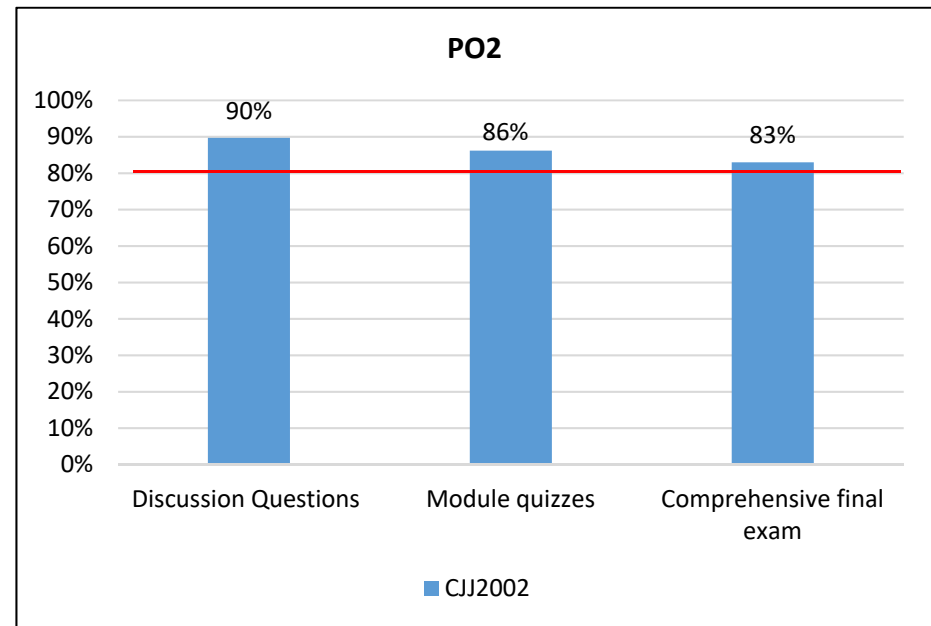


Exhibit professional behaviors within the field of Criminal Justice.

Criminal Justice Technology Bridge – 2039 Assessment Results 2017-2018

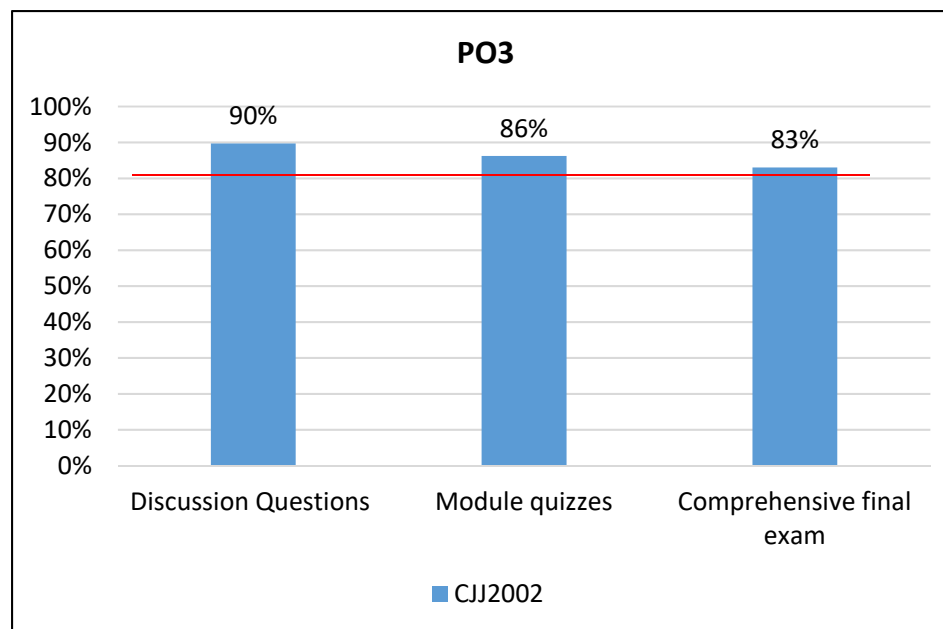


Exhibit cultural appropriate behavior within the field of Criminal Justice.

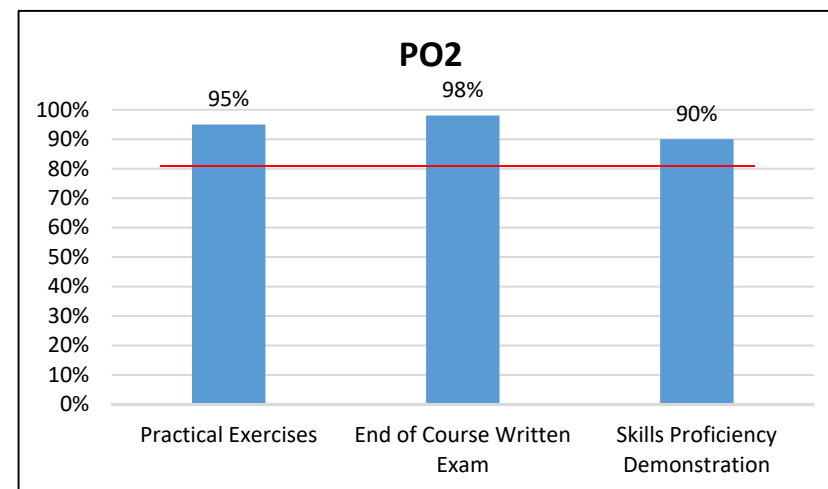

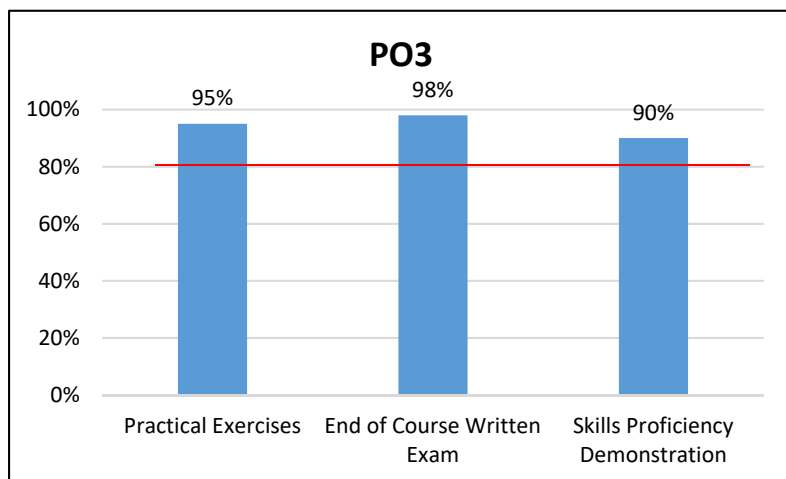
