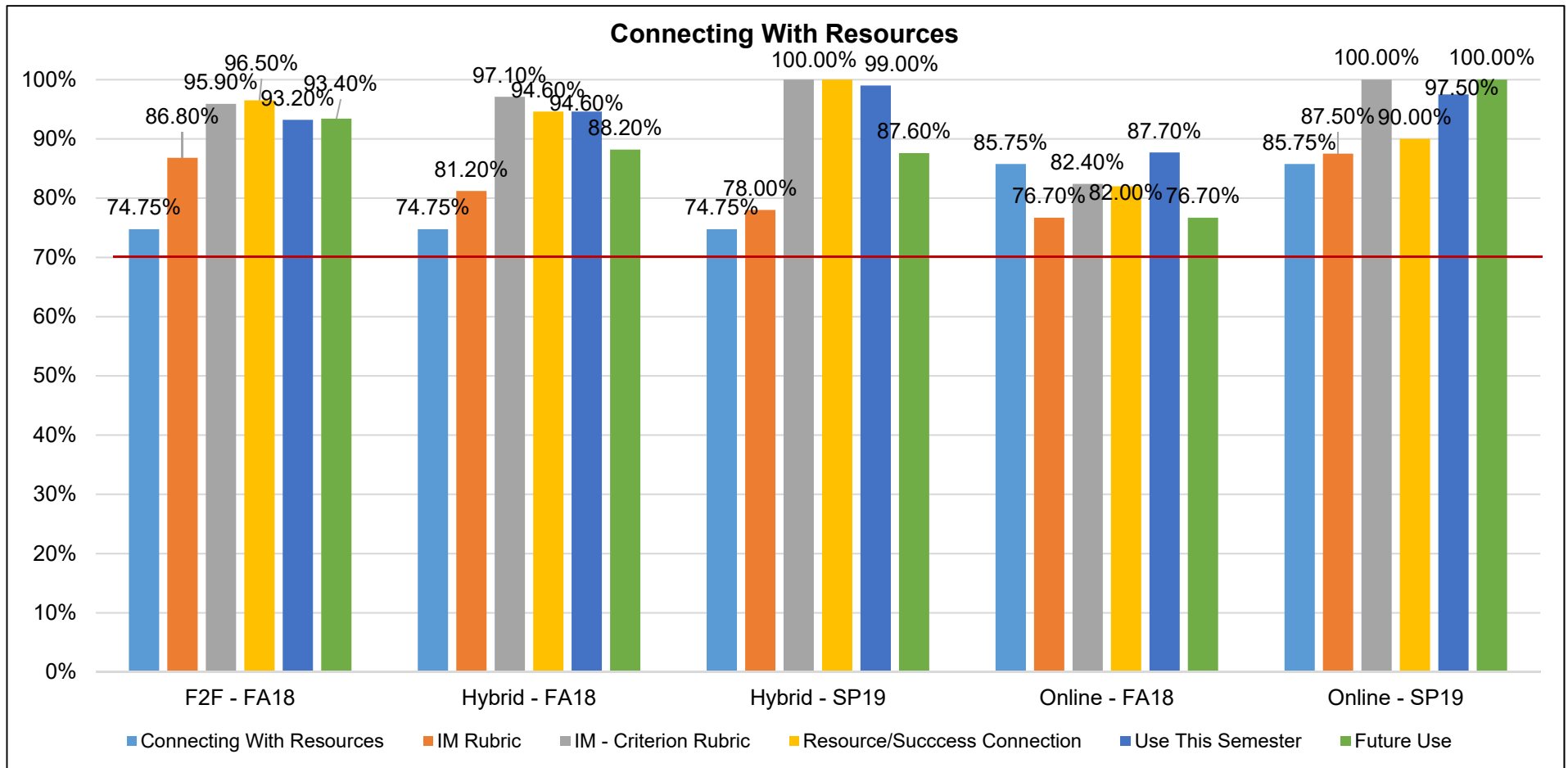
Measuring CLO1, CLO2, and CLO4

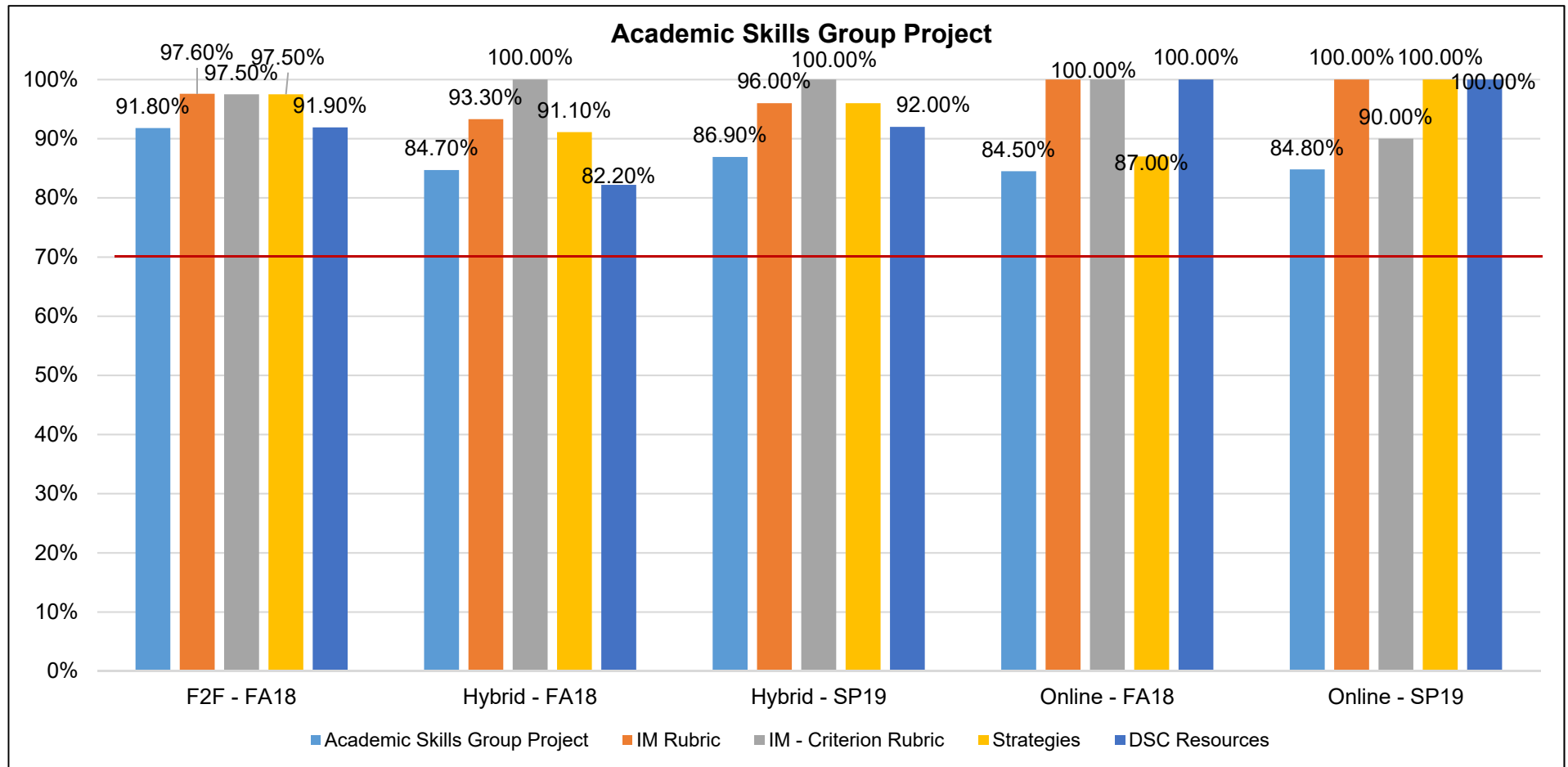
Measuring CLO1 and CLO2

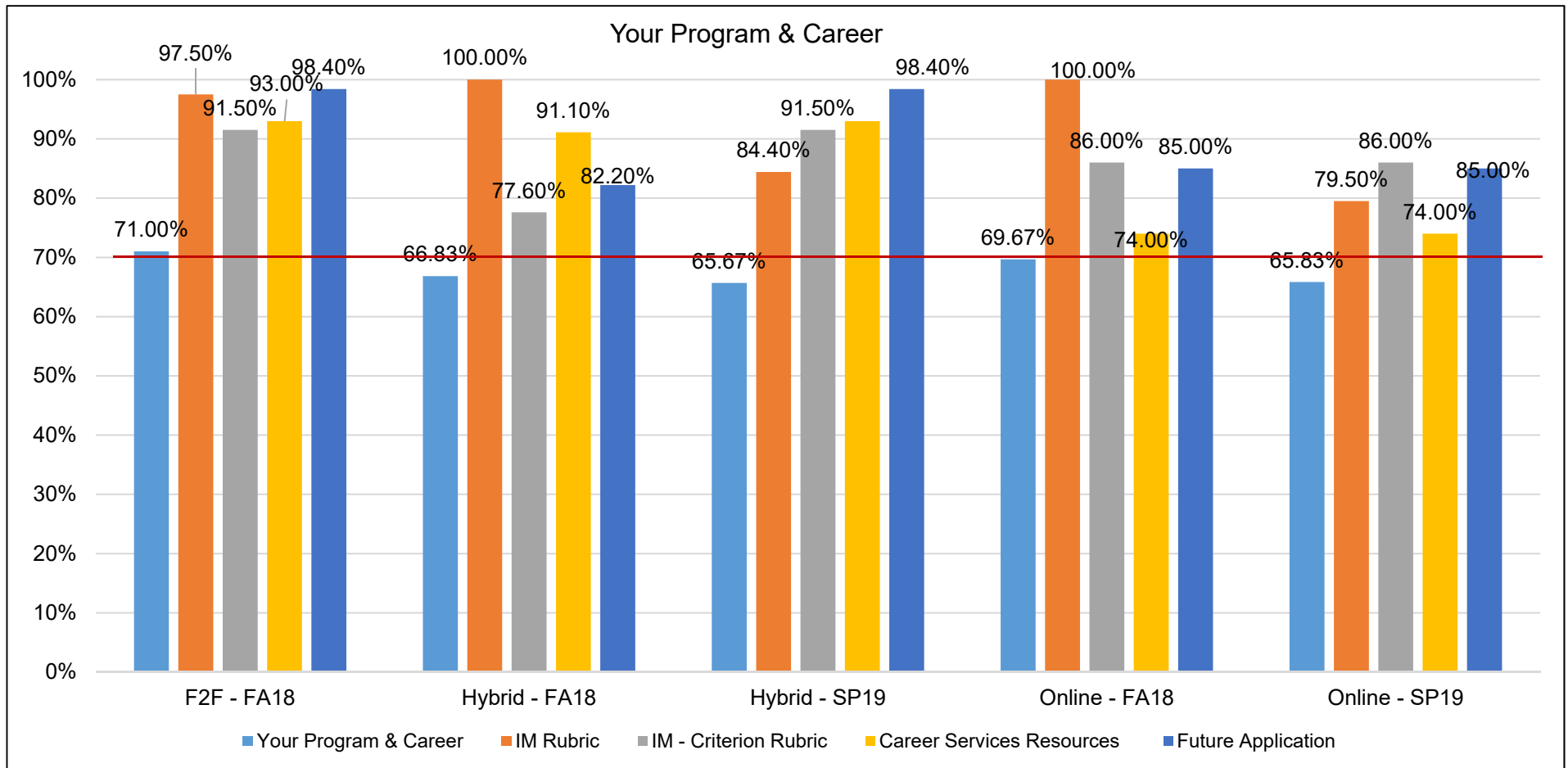

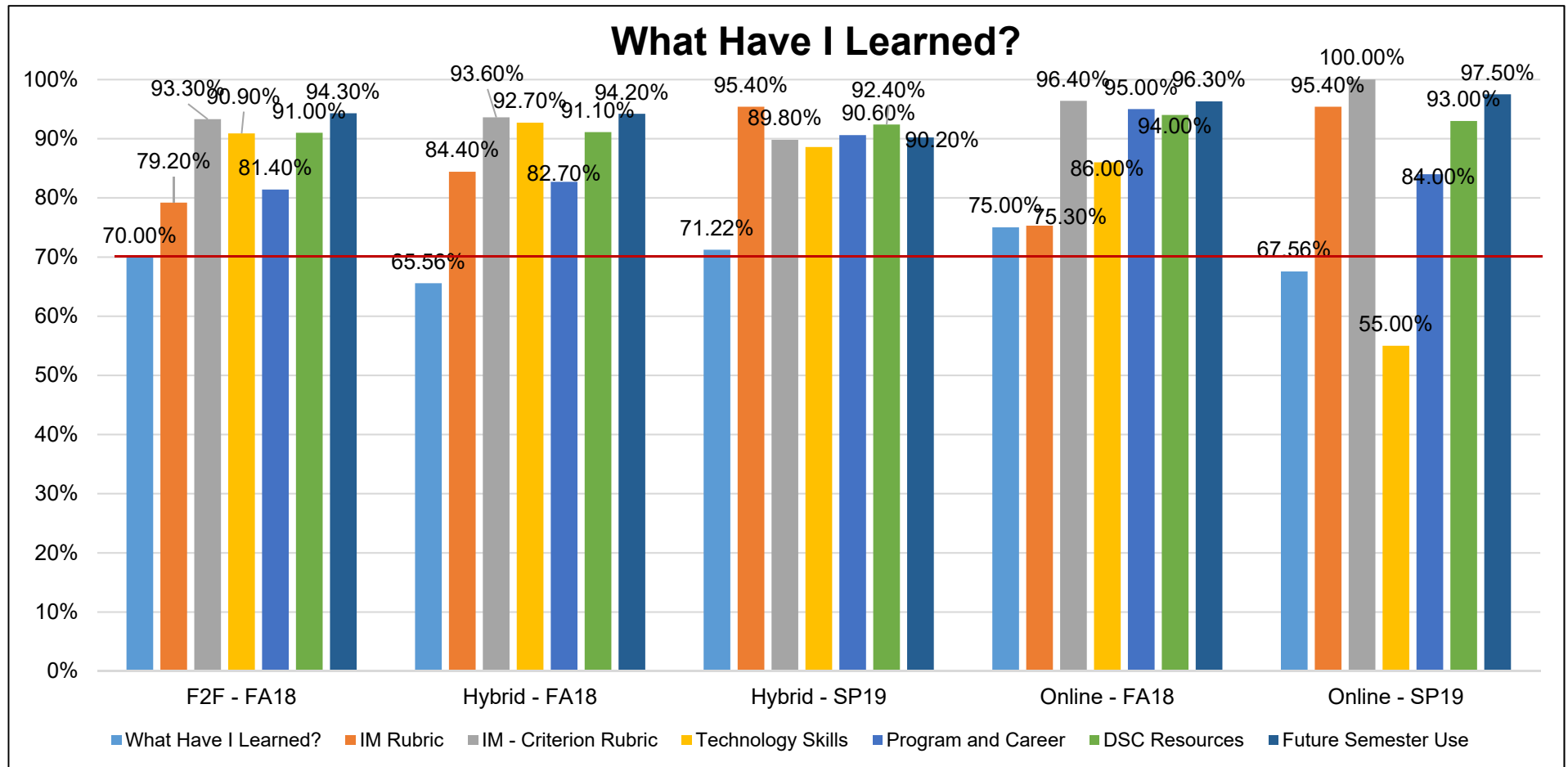

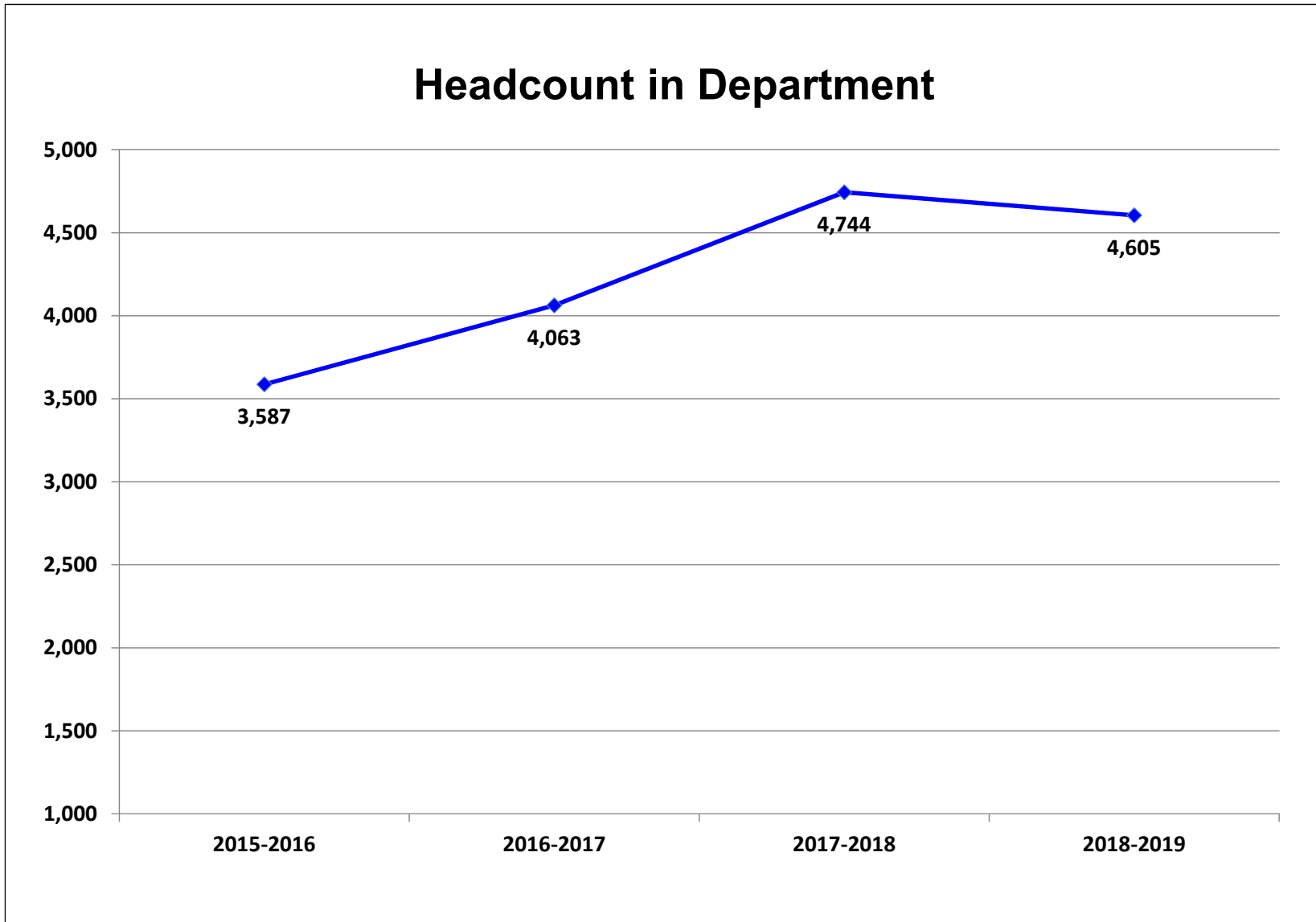

Earning a C in SLS-1122 is a Yellow Flag signal.

Students with a C in SLS-1122 tend to persist, but they graduate at a rate far lower than students with better grades.

- Students with a C in SLS-1122 are 73.9% likely to persist, but only 32.7% likely to graduate
- Students with a C in SLS-1122 who do persist are 20.9% less likely to graduate than persisting students with higher grades. This drop is 1.6X larger in SLS-1122 than in the average 1st year course.
