OUT OF STATE FEE WAIVER FOR VETERANS

In accordance with statute 1009.26(13)(a), Veterans who have been honorably discharged from the US military are eligible to receive a fee waiver for the out of state portion of their tuition or any Veteran/Dependent using GI benefits to pay for their tuition. The Veteran or dependent must provide clear documentation that they are residing in the state of Florida while attending classes. The following items must be attached:

1. DD214 documenting an Honorable Discharge or an eligibility certificate for dependants
2. Florida Driver’s License /ID card or other documentation approved by Assistant Director of Admissions

3 YEAR HIGH SCHOOL OUT OF STATE FEE WAIVER

In accordance with statute 1009.26 (12)(a), students who have attended a secondary school in this state for 3 consecutive years immediately before graduating from a high school in this state and applied for enrollment at a Florida College System institution within 24 months after high school are eligible to receive a waiver for the out of state portion of their tuition. This waiver is only applicable for 110 percent of the required credit hours of the degree or certificate program for which the student is enrolled. Students receiving this waiver are not eligible for state financial aid, including Bright Futures.

The student must submit the following:

1. Final high school transcript (including graduation date) indicating 3 consecutive years attendance immediately before graduation
2. If applying to Daytona State College after the 24 month period, please provide official documentation of application to another Florida College System institution.

HOMELESS WAIVER

In accordance with statute 1009.25 (1)(f), students who lack a fixed residence are eligible to receive a waiver for their tuition. Students must provide a letter on letterhead from an agency whose mission is to assist homeless individuals. Letters must be dated within 30 days of the start date of classes. Letters will be verified one week prior to the start date of classes. The student must still be receiving services from the agency at the time of verification.

The following items must be attached:

1. Letter on letterhead from an agency that provides services to homeless individuals stating that the student is currently homeless and receiving services. The letter must be dated within 30 days of the start date of classes.

By signing this form, I understand that waivers are only valid for **one** semester. Receipt of one of these waivers **does not** result in classification as a Florida Resident for Tuition Purposes. If I wish to seek this waiver in a subsequent semester, I must reapply and provide the required documentation.
