



## **Collegiate High School Application 2020-21**

Daytona State College / Volusia County Schools / Flagler County Schools

The Collegiate High School Program is an early admission dual enrollment program between the Volusia and Flagler County public school systems, and Daytona State College.

### **Benefits:**

- Students who complete all courses successfully and start in the 11th grade will earn an Associate's degree by the time they graduate from high school.
- Books will still be provided by the student's high school.
- Students will still be eligible to graduate with their high school class.
- Dual enrollment staff will be working with the high school counselors to make sure student is meeting high school requirements.

Interested students must complete the Collegiate High School Application, as well as the Dual Enrollment Form with their Guidance Counselor, and be admitted to Daytona State College. This can be done at any of the Daytona State College Campuses – Daytona, DeLand, Deltona, Flagler/Palm Coast, and New Smyrna Beach.

**The deadline for the 20-21 school year is June 15, 2020.**

### **Eligibility requirements:**

- ✓ Must be a public school student enrolled in 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade during the 20-21 school year.
- ✓ Have a 3.2 or higher unweighted high school GPA.
- ✓ Test into both ENC 1101 – Intro to Composition, and MAC 1105 – College Algebra, on the PERT, SAT or ACT.
- ✓ Agree to take 15-16 credit hours at DSC during the Fall 20 & Spring 21 semesters.
- ✓ Attend a mandatory orientation during the summer.
- ✓ Sign the Collegiate High School contract, identifying the courses necessary for their degree.  
\*This may include summer courses during their Junior & Senior year of high school.
- ✓ Maintain a minimum 2.5 College GPA
- ✓ Declare an eligible college major (Majors are listed on the application).
- ✓ Students in the A.S. programs will be eligible for Cape Industry Certifications.
- ✓ Admitted students will be required to enroll in courses necessary for their major and/or high school graduation.
- ✓ Students who withdraw (from one class) or earn a "D" will be moved to regular dual enrollment IF their high school and college GPA still qualify them to participate.
- ✓ Students who withdraw from two or more classes will no longer be eligible to dual enroll.
- ✓ Students who earn an "F" will no longer be eligible to participate.
