

## **Daytona State College Dual Enrollment Test/Retest rules**

### **College Placement Test (CPT)** – Used for College Credit Programs

1. Initial Test (can be taken at the college or during on-site testing days at the high schools).
2. Re-test – Students can retake all or part of the CPT exam 24 hours after the initial testing. The high school counselor should refer the student to an Academic Advisor at DSC for a retest slip. There is no charge for retests for Dual Enrollment Students.
3. Second retest – Students can take the CPT a third and final time if needed only after they have completed a full semester of high school.

### **Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE)** – Used for PSAV programs

1. Initial Test (taken at the college Assessment Center)
2. Re-test – Students can retake the TABE after 24 hours. The high school counselor should refer the student to an Academic Advisor at DSC for a retest slip. Students will be given another version of the TABE (TABE 'A').
3. Second retest – Students must wait a minimum of 6 months prior to their third and final attempt at the TABE test.
