The Nursing Department will first select applicants that have completed all pre and co-requisite courses with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and higher. The second group to be selected will be the applicants who have completed all pre and co-requisite courses with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 - 2.99.

All remaining applicants will be selected if spaces remain based on how many pre and co-requisite courses have been completed and **preference** will be given to applicants who complete all of the courses in the order listed above.
