SELECTION PROCESS: * Category 1 - Successful completion of ALL the required nursing pre and co-requisite courses with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better. * Category 2 - Successful completion of ALL the required nursing pre and co-requisite courses with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 to 2.99 or better. * Category 3 - Students with outstanding pre or co-requisite courses. Applicants are given priority of admission within each category based upon: A. Cumulative GPA. B. TEAS reading comprehension score. C. TEAS mathematics score. D. TEAS adjusted individual total score (AITS). *Courses listed above are in order of recommended priority and weight.

TEAS results must meet the minimum requirements in reading comprehension and mathematics, and an adjusted individual total score (AITS). Students who have previously taken the Nurse Entrance Test (NET) may submit an application with NET test scores at the 50th percentile or better in each category (mathematics, reading and overall composite, scores expire 2 years to the day test was taken). Applications submitted after January 1, 2012 must include original TEAS scores; NET scores will not be accepted after January 1, 2012.

Recommended BSN Prerequisites

Program Code - 7955 (Pre-BSN AA)

The requirements listed below are recommended for students with an AS degree in Nursing who wish to complete the Associate of Arts (AA) degree with the prerequisites for transfer to a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN). Students who want to transfer to a State of Florida University for a BSN (RN transition) are recommended to complete an AA degree in addition to completing the RN/AS Degree at DSC. This list includes the courses that remain to complete the AA degree and the RN transition to BSN degree prerequisites at the State Universities. These courses are NOT required as a part of the DSC RN (2171) program. These courses, in addition, to the DSC RN pre/co requisites, will fulfill AA degree and BSN (RN Transition) degree prerequisites for State of Florida Universities. These requirements are found in the prerequisite manual on www.FACTS.org, students should always consult with the intended transfer institution for exact admissions requirements.

- Completion of all 9 of the Pre/Co Requisites for the DSC RN (2171) program
- STA2023 Elementary Statistics (2nd Math Core) (3 credits) (MAC1105 or MGF2106 as a prerequisite)
- HUN1201 Human Nutrition (Health & Wellness Core) (3 credits)
- CHMXXX Chemistry or PHYXXX (Physical Science Core) (4 credits) (MAT1033 or higher as a prerequisite or corequisite)
Students can also take courses with BCHXXXX, BSCXXXX, or PCBXXXX to meet the prerequisite requirement for the BSN programs but those courses will not count for Physical Science Core for AA, additional course work would be required to meet AA requirements. Students are strongly encouraged to contact transfer school for preference.
