Would you like to be a certified lifeguard? A Red Cross Certified Lifeguard Course will be offered at the Daytona Campus Aquatic Center, Bldg. 310 starting Thursday, March 1, 2012. Each class must be attended to be certified.

You must be able to pass the pre-test scheduled at the Daytona State Aquatic Center. Pre-test consists of the following:

300 yd swim (not timed)

100 yd freestyle, 100 yd breaststroke, 100 yd either one
2 min tread (kick only), Retrieve a brick from bottom of pool under 1 minute 40 seconds
