You must be able to pass the pre-test consisting of:

Have proficiency in the following skills:

Front Crawl (25 yds), Back Crawl (25 yds), Breastroke (25 yds), Elementary Backstroke (25 yds), Sidestroke (25 yds), & Butterfly (15 yds)

Maintain position on back 1 minute in deep water

Tread Water for 1 minute
