

Student Right-to-Know Fall 2007 Graduation Rate Survey (GRS) Report

The Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, as amended by the Higher Educational Technical Assistance Amendments of 1991, require that all institutions participating in Title IV student financial assistance programs disclose the graduation rate for the most recent cohort of full time, first time in college students who have graduated within 150% of the normal time frame for their degree.

Graduation and Completion Rates

One of the measures of excellence in teaching and learning is the rate at which students complete their programs of study and/or transfer to four-year universities. Students enrolled at Daytona State College met the following criteria for this report:

- Indicated they were seeking a degree or certificate
- Enrolled in college for the first time in the Fall
- Enrolled for at least twelve semester hours

- 32.5% - indicated they have completed their degrees or certificate
- 10.1% - have transferred without a degree or certificate to another public community college or university in Florida
