

# IPAD USER GUIDE

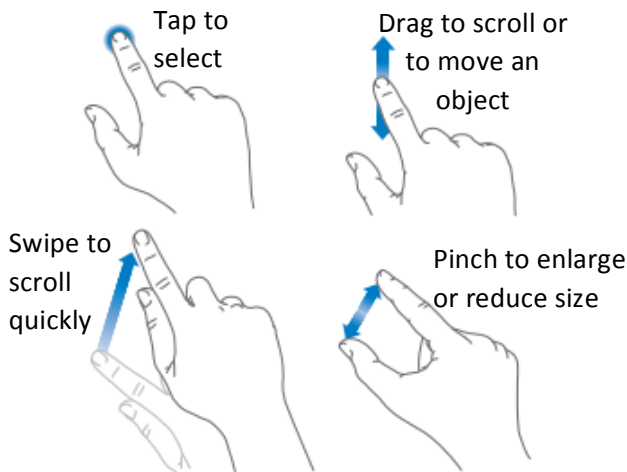
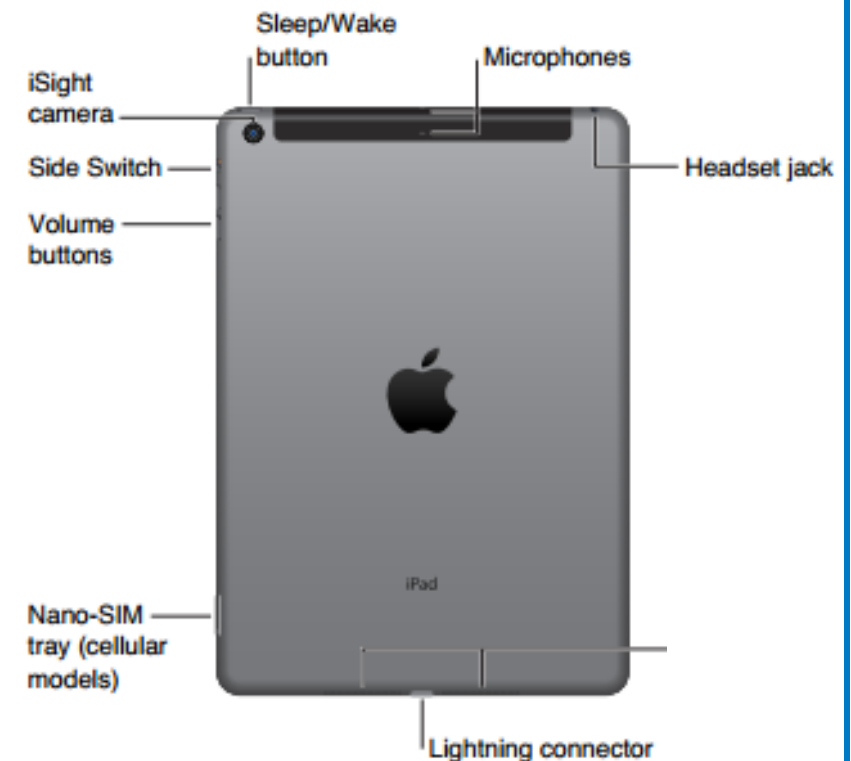
To open the iPad, push the Home button.

To open an app, tap on the app icon.

To return to the Home screen, press the Home button.

To view recently used apps: double-click the Home button and swipe left.

Drag up or down to scroll on the screen.  
Flick to scroll quickly. You can wait for the scrolling to come to a stop or touch anywhere on the screen to stop the scrolling immediately.




Editing Text: touch and hold to bring up the magnifying glass then drag to position the insertion point.

Select text: Tap the insertion point to display selection buttons. Tap Select to select adjacent word or Select All to select all text.

To type uppercase: Tap the Shift Key before tapping a letter.

To enter numbers, punctuation, or symbols, tap the Number key.

To see additional punctuation and symbols, tap the Symbol key.
