



WAC/WID @ Daytona State: Faculty Mentorship Program Application

The Faculty Mentorship Program seeks to build relationships among faculty members across disciplines. The goal of this program is to support faculty as they develop classroom strategies that facilitate student success. This professional development opportunity is open to all faculty members at Daytona State College.

What can I expect as a participant?

This is a one semester commitment in which you will interact with a mentor and a small cohort of peers. The interactions will vary between participants, but will include an orientation, three cohort meetings, and periodic one-on-one interactions with your mentor.

During the cohort meetings, you can expect to discuss current scholarship and research related to Teaching and Learning. All cohort meetings are held on Friday afternoons from 1-2:30pm in the Writing Center Cellar (Building 200/Room 107D).

2017 Cohort Meeting Schedule

- September 15, 2017: Orientation *light refreshments provided*
- October 13, 2017: Teaching and Learning Discussion/Workshop
- November 10, 2017: Teaching and Learning Discussion/Workshop
- December 1, 2017: Graduation/Wrap-Up/Party *light refreshments provided*

The individual work that you do with your mentor will be tailored to your specific needs or wants as a faculty member, and the goal(s) that you set for the semester. If you're new to the College or the WAC/WID program, your goals may include developing course material, gaining a deeper understanding of the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning, or becoming familiar with the College and its resources more fully. If you've already done work in the program, your goals may be related to further implementation of WAC/WID principles and practices in your classroom.

In addition to any artifacts that you create, upon completion of the program, you will receive a letter from your mentor outlining the work done over the semester and a certificate of completion to be used for professional development credit. This professional development opportunity is also designed to prepare you for further opportunities at the College – including more work in the WAC/WID Program or an opportunity to present on an aspect of your experience at the yearly Academic Excellence Symposium.
