## Who's Eligible?

The Upward Bound Program serves students who:

Are enrolled in high school (grades 9-12) at designated Volusia County high schools.\*

Demonstrate financial need according to federal income guidelines.

Are first-generation college bound (neither parent/ legal guardian completed a four-year degree).

Show a strong interest in and potential for college admission.

\*Designated schools: Deltona High School, Mainland High School and Pine Ridge High School

**How to Enroll:** Pick up an application from the Upward Bound office on the Daytona State College, Daytona Beach or Deltona campus, or from the guidance counselor at a designated high school.

Applications are accepted throughout the year; admission to the program is based on eligibility and space available.

# Upward Bound

## AN OPPORTUNITY FOR SUCCESS



TRiO Upward Bound creates a myriad of opportunities by motivating, educating, promoting and supporting its students.

Upward Bound is a federally funded program that has been offered through Daytona State College since 2004. The program provides valuable services for eligible students to succeed in high school and matriculate into college. It is housed on the Daytona Beach and Deltona campuses, serving 100 students each year.

Students are afforded the opportunity to participate in educational activities to build their academic skills, increase motivation and improve self-confidence. Personal, career and academic counseling, prescriptive instruction and tutorial assistance in math, science, English and foreign languages are key components in the program.

Students are also eligible to receive incentive stipends and participate in educational and cultural enrichment activities. The program administers Saturday and Summer Academies and culminates with the Summer Bridge program, transitioning the graduating high school seniors to their first year as college students.

### PROGRAM SERVICES

#### TUTORING

The tutorial program is a supplement to classroom instruction, individual study and preparation. Students will receive tutoring twice a week in core courses and reinforcement of the school's academic curriculum.

#### SATURDAY SESSIONS

Each session features highly interactive, technology-enhanced learning activities that strengthen the students' basic skills and academic curriculum; other topics examined include study skills, critical thinking and research.

#### COLLEGE PLANNING

Students will be guided to a college preparatory curriculum to ensure they have a basic academic foundation to meet the entrance requirements for the state's university system. Activities focus on preparation for PSAT, FCAT, ACT and SAT testing, individual educational and personal development plans, career planning and college campus visits.

#### ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Another program highlight is the enrichment activities which promote student involvement at conferences, cultural activities and social events. Expanding students' experiences encourages creative development and allows exposure to new ideas and alternative points of view.

#### SUMMER ACADEMY

The six week academy simulates the college experience with academic sessions that build upon the foundation students have acquired throughout the year. Refining computer skills, practicing team efforts and becoming familiar with post-secondary services round out the planned sessions.

#### SUMMER BRIDGE

After high school graduation, Upward Bound seniors participate in the final component of the program. The objective is to foster a successful transition from high school to college. Students are able to enroll in two general education courses that will transfer to all local colleges/universities and may participate in the summer enrichment activities.
