BASIC EKG

This course will teach you how to:

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of anatomy and physiology of the heart.
- Demonstrate lead placement for monitoring patients.
- Recognize the elements of the EKG: PR interval, QRS duration, QT interval, atrial and ventricular rates.
- Read rhythm strips: sinus rhythm, atrial fibrillation, heart block, etc.
- Recognize the hemodynamic effects of dysrhythmias.

Directions to Building 320 on campus:
