Surrounding Cities:

- ◆ Daytona Beach has the largest number (1,374) and percent (18.2) of the Asian population in the county.
- ◆ Holly Hill population decreased by (-3.9%) in the last decade from 12,119 in 2000 to 11,659 for 2010. One out of every five homes in the city are vacant (1,465, vacancy rate 21.2%) .
- ◆ Ormond Beach population increased by 1,836 (4.8%) in the last decade from 36,301 in 2000 to 38,137 for 2010. It also ranks 4th in the county with largest number (864) and percent (11.4) of the Asian population.
