Program Prerequisite and Corequisite Requirements

IMPORTANT

Because you are entering a degree program, it is necessary for you to complete both general education requirements as well as courses in your major in order for you to graduate.

In your general education requirements you have prerequisites and corequisites; prerequisites are courses that must be taken prior to taking a class; corequisites are classes that you must take along with another class.

Below is a list of the prerequisites and corequisites for each of the tracts of the Associate Degree Nursing Program. **If** you do not meet the deadlines for either the prerequisite or corequisite requirement, you will not be allowed to progress in the nursing program. You will be allowed one semester to rectify the situation before being removed from your position on the list.

You must complete, in order of priority, the courses as they are presented on the list to ensure that you allow plenty of time to complete the designated pre or corequisites by the time you are to enter the program/course.
