We have good news regarding your BAS textbooks!

In an effort to serve you better, we're no longer administering the BAS Club textbook rental program through our offices. The textbooks have now been **moved to the Daytona State College library system** where you can check them out at the circulation desk through the 2015-2016 academic year with **no fee!** This new system offers you extended hours of operation and reduced cost with **no textbook rental fees!**

Here's what you need to know about the new system:

- Where can I return my summer books? You can return your summer books to the BAS Book Dropbox in building 150, to the Circulation Desk at the Daytona or Deland library, or to the Academic Support Center on the Flagler/Palm Coast, New Smyrna/Edgewater, or Deltona campus. Please return your summer books as early as possible to help with the transition to this new system.
- When can I check out fall books? The Daytona State College library system will have BAS textbooks available for checkout beginning Thursday, August 21st at the Daytona Campus. The library hours are available here: http://www.daytonastate.edu/library/
- What if I live closer to another DSC campus? If you need your textbooks interoffice mailed to the Deland library, the Flagler/Palm Coast ASC, the New Smyrna/Edgewater ASC, or the Deltona ASC, check the contact info at the bottom of this message to learn how to request your books.
- What do I need in order to check out a book? A copy of your schedule and your student ID.
- **How much does this cost**? Nothing! Unless you don't return your books at the end of the course. In that case, you'd be charged late fines and, eventually, a textbook replacement fee.
- What if I live too far away? What if I don't want to use the library system? What if I prefer to buy my textbook? The library system is just one way to access BAS texts. Every course syllabus includes textbook information and you're always welcome to purchase textbooks from the online retailer of your choice. For Fall B, we expect the Daytona State College bookstore to carry textbooks for those students who wish to purchase texts with financial aid book vouchers.
- What if the library runs out of textbooks for my course? The library will keep copies on reserve at the Daytona Beach and Deland locations. And you are, of course, always free to purchase the textbooks from the retailer of your choice. The library cannot "hold" books for any student on any campus. Come early to be assured a textbook check-out!
