Specialized Course

This one day, 8 hour class is designed to increase the speed and accuracy of the shotgun shooter. This 200 round tactical shotgun class will present the student with a better understanding of the versatility of the shotgun as used in the correctional officer environment.

Topics to be covered: Close range and long range shooting, weapon transition, engaging multiple targets, movement and cover drills, clearing malfunctions, practical shooting scenarios.

NOTE Equipment Student MUST provide:

Agency shotgun and sling
200 rounds of shotgun ammo 8 or 9 pellet **and** 100 rounds of handgun ammo
Body armor, duty belt, handgun, eye/ear protection. Appropriate long pants, shirt, hat are required. Hydrating beverages/water and note taking material should be brought to class.
