Salary Incentive or Mandatory Re-Training

This 40 Hour CJSTC Course is required by Florida Statue 316 for an officer to issue citations for motorists exceeding the speed limit, while the officer is using a speed measurement device.

Topics: Laser and Radar speed measurement theory, equipment operation, calibration, court room testimony, speed offenses, speed estimation techniques, stationary and moving speed measurement techniques, and practical field exercises.

Students are required to take and pass a written exam at 80% and all practical speed measurement activities.

Instructors: Jerry Riggins and DSC Adjunct Instructors

NOTE Equipment: Students must bring and wear during field exercises a DOT approved reflective vest. The student must have an agency marked or unmarked patrol vehicle, and the agency Laser / Radar unit for officer's use during practical exercises. Students should bring a hat and sunscreen and hydrating beverages or water for days 3-5 while in the field.
