This training course will give attendees the tools needed to properly plan and execute an operation whether it pertains to a short term investigation or a long term more involved investigation.

Through the course of this four day specialized training program attendees will be brought up to date on current trends in drug trafficking and will receive information in a variety of different areas including money laundering and working federal firearms violations. Simply put attendees will be prepared at the end of this conference to work a target from a variety of different approaches that should ultimately lead them to their investigative goals.

Converting gang members into cooperating sources is a difficult if not impossible task in many circumstances. Attendees will learn what triggers a gang member's behavior and how to use the gang member's mindset and value system against him to bring him over to the right side of the law.

Working gang, narcotics and undercover investigations can be very stressful to an officer. Coupled with the day to day stress incurred in life it can sometimes become physically and emotionally draining. Stress management techniques will be given to attendees so that they can deal with what happens to them both on and off the job.

The instructors for this conference have many years of experience in narcotics, gang and undercover operations and have a wealth of information to share with attendees of this program. This is truly a unique program as it cross trains attendees in a variety of different types of investigations and investigative techniques. This program is a must for anyone serious about working gangs, undercover or narcotics investigations.

Steve is an expert in the area of Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs and has been featured in many news publications, radio and television interviews in the US, England and Australia and appeared on seasons 2 and 3 of the History Channel program "Gangland".

Pat Fielding- Pat is a Detective with a Police Department in the Las Vegas area and has over 22 years of law enforcement experience. Pat has been assigned to numerous narcotics, gang, and criminal intelligence units, as well as several HIDTA groups, including a FBI Major Drug Trafficking Organizations Task Force, DEA Methamphetamine Task Force, Club Drug Task Force and is currently assigned to a ICE Money Laundering Task Force. Pat has worked both undercover and as an investigator for 20 years investigating narcotics organizations, outlaw biker and street gangs, money laundering, arms and explosives dealers, auto-theft and stolen property rings, murder for hires, political corruption and conducted storefront operations.

Jim Dillman- Jim is an Intelligence Detective with the Collier County, Florida Sheriff's Office and has over 35 years of law enforcement experience. Jim is assigned to the Organized Crime Bureau and is currently a member of the FBI Violent Crime Task Force. Jim is President of the Florida Intelligence Unit (FIU). Jim has been involved in intelligence operations on outlaw motorcycle gangs in Florida, and Pennsylvania and is versed in surveillance and intelligence gathering on outlaw motorcycle gang gatherings. Jim also has extensive experience in long term OCDETF investigations and Title III Electronic Intercepts of major Drug Trafficking Organizations involving International gangs.
