Daytona State College Safety Protocol

Daytona State College is committed to implementing certain protocols to maintain a safe environment to all faculty, staff, students and visitors. The following protocols/procedures seek to implement commonsense, research-based procedures. These procedures are consistent with CDC guidelines on how to protect yourself and others while allowing for the face-to-face contact.

- All DSC faculty, staff, and students are required to wear a face covering while in any building on campus. Individuals will supply their own face covering.
- Social distancing procedures are in place and include staying at least 6 feet.
- Frequent handwashing is required. Hands must be washed before entering the lab or classroom for the first time and upon re-entry for any reason (i.e. anyone leaving a room must clean hands upon re-entry; handwashing must occur before and after bathroom breaks; handwashing must occur before and after eating).
- For activities that require gloves, gloves should be changed and discarded regularly between activities and when individuals leave the classroom or lab area.
- There should be no sharing of tools, utensils, instruments, or other portable equipment or materials during a class or lab.

If students refuse to comply with any of these procedures, the faculty member may ask the student to leave, or Campus Safety may be notified, and the student may be removed from the lab or classroom and dismissed from the summer career exploration camp.
