COURSE: This course is designed to provide criminal justice officers with the skills and techniques for conducting effective interviews during an investigation.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: Introduction, Legal Issues, Preparing for an Interview, Interview Techniques, Conducting an Interview, Interviewing Juveniles, Interviewing Victims of Sexual Assault, and Aiding Eyewitness Identification during Show-Ups and Photo Lineups.

NOTE: Students should have successfully completed the basic recruit training program or have been exempted prior to taking this course. Students will be required to participate in role-play exercises to apply the concepts and skills taught in this course. Students are required to pass an end-of-course examination with a minimum of 80%. Students must attend all sessions of the course.
