All students must hold an active General Instructor Techniques Certification PRIOR to attending this course and 3 years experience on patrol.

ATTIRE: BDU style long pants with belt loops, wrestling/tennis shoes, multiple t-shirts, clean towel daily, socks, and hydrating beverages. A mouthpiece and groin protection are recommended. **Please note that shorts are** <u>NOT</u> **permitted**.

NOTE: Students are required to pass a written exam with a score of 85% or better and demonstrate the required proficiency skills at 100% pursuant to Rule 11B-35.0024. Students must participate in teaching a mini lesson of the course to their peers in the classroom.

- Training gun (if you have one)
