COURSE: This specialized course provides an overview of investigating human trafficking crimes for the officer and investigator with limited experience in this area. This 16-hour course will provide a framework for initiating and conducting investigations of human trafficking offenses. Students must attend all sessions of the course.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: Nature and Scope of Human Trafficking, Building Multi-Agency Partnerships, Federal and State Human Trafficking/Smuggling Laws, Victimology, Trafficker Typology, Conducting a Proactive/Reactive Investigation, RICO/Money Laundering and Human Trafficking Offenses, Victim Rescue and Restoration, and Interviewing Witnesses/Victims Coordinating Prosecution.

NOTE: This course is not offered by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and is not approved by the Criminal Justice Standards & Training Commission (CJSTC) to meet the Mandatory Human Trafficking Training requirements of s. 943.17297.

INSTRUCTOR: Special Agent Supervisor Jose Ramirez. Special Agent Ramirez has 24 years of law enforcement experience and currently leads the Major Case Investigations Squad at FDLE in Miami.
