COURSE: This course is designed to provide non-Spanish speaking criminal justice professionals with the basic Spanish language skills needed to communicate criminal justice commands. Students are encouraged to bring a basic English-Spanish dictionary.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: Hispanic Culture, Spanish Alphabet, Cognates, Pronouns, Articles, and Gender, Greetings, Giving Directions, Basic Interviewing, and Criminal Justice Vocabulary.

NOTE: Students will be required to participate in both scenarios and exercises to apply the concepts and skills taught in the course. Students are required to pass an end-of-course examination with a minimum of 80%. Students must attend all sessions of the course.
