Center for Women & Men Scholarship Criteria for 2016-2017

Candidates must complete the DSC Foundation Scholarship application online prior to the deadline for each semester. Contact the DSC Foundation for application timelines: Fall-July, Spring-December and Summer-April.

Candidates must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to establish financial need. All candidates must be Pell Grant eligible according to your FAFSA.

All candidates must have a written referral by a Center for Women & Men (CFWM) staff member or CFWM Instructor. Candidates must have written approval by the Director (CFWM).

Candidates must be an active participant in or have completed a Center for Women & Men Program (Fresh Start, CCAMPIS or New Directions) within one major semester (Fall or Spring) of the application year. All second semester or continuing students must have a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Recipients must write a thank you letter to the DSC Foundation and the Center for Women & Men within five business days of the official award notice. Award notices are sent to your DSC Falconet account. Failure to complete the thank you letter within the stated timeframe will render the scholarship null and void.

Recipients must commit to providing 30 hours of volunteer service in the Center for Women & Men during the semester of the award. Recipient must attend the Annual Women's History Month Luncheon sponsored by the Center for Women & Men held in March.

The scholarship is only a onetime award. The scholarship (if awarded) must be used in same semester. Example: If awarded for Fall 2016, the scholarship must be used for the Fall 2016.

The scholarship is not an add-on. Example: If awarded, other types of aid may be reduced such as student loans. Check with the Financial Aid Office to determine the impact on any other types of aid you may have.

REVISED AMOUNTS

The award amount will be prorated based on the students' enrollment. To be eligible student must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours (vocational or college credit). Example: 6 hours of enrollment = \$500.00 award, 7 to 10 hours = \$850.00, 11 to 14 hours = \$1000.00 and 15 or more hours = \$1200.00.
