Dear Delta Dental PPO Plan Member,

We are writing to clarify an important update regarding your Delta Dental PPO plans out-of-network benefits. Out-of-network reimbursement is based on PPO contracted fees, and not a percentage of each dentists submitted fees.

The maximum contract allowance is the total on which Delta Dental bases its portion of the fee. Please note, if you go to an out-of-network dentist, this amount may be lower than the accepted fee. The contract benefit level is the percent of the maximum contract allowance that's paid by your dental plan. The difference between the accepted fee and what Delta Dental pays, based on the maximum contract allowance times the contract benefit level, is what you owe. This process is known as balance billing. Any time a member visits an out-of-network dentist there will be balance billing.

The examples below are for illustrative purposes only; actual submitted fees and maximum contract allowances will vary.
