This waiver is only applicable for 110 percent of the required credit hours of the deg or certificate program for which the student is enrolled. Students receiving this waiver are not eligible for st financial aid, including Bright Futures. The student must submit the following: 1. Final high school transcript (including graduation date) indicating 3 consecutive years attendard immediately before graduation 2. If applying to Daytona State College after the 24 month period, please provide office documentation of application to another Florida College System institution.
