Best Officer Survival Shooting Techniques!

This 2 day shooting course is what every patrol officer needs to survive armed encounters on the street. It deals with engaging multiple targets, multiple times with speed and accuracy. Topics include: shooting safely multiple targets, using cover and concealment, transition drills, tactical reloading/drawing, engaging multiple target threats, target transfer and shooting/moving, shooting on steel tactical range.

NOTE: Students must bring to class:

750 rounds of frangible handgun ammo---Ammo is not provided by DSC
