FDLE Specialized Course- mandatory retraining use only

The purpose of the course is to prepare an instructor to obtain FDLE certification as a High Liability Instructor in Vehicle Operations and instruct the Law Enforcement Vehicle Operations Course in the Florida Basic Recruit Training Program or agency in-service. The training is to familiarize students with issues that may involve high liability and/or high stress activities. FDLE urges students to ensure that their practices are correct in accordance with their agency policies and procedures.

Students should bring: note taking materials, a folding chair, hydrating beverages, hat, sunglasses, closed toe shoes, snacks, lunch to class daily, **A Flashlight and DOT approved reflective vest is required. NO RED SHIRTS.**

NOTE: Instructor students must take a written exam and obtain a score of 85% or better and demonstrate skill proficiency on all exercises at 100% accuracy. Students must have completed the Instructor Techniques Course PRIOR to enrolling in this class. *This is a DSC requirement (not per FDLE).*
