Whether you are the first officer on the scene or the lead investigator, this course will give you the knowledge to professionally investigate any possible death situation. You will become familiar with how forensic sciences can assist you in your investigation.

Students must pass a written final exam with 80% or better.

- Causes and manner of death & wound identification
- Child death investigations
- Medical Examiner procedures
