Mental Health First Aid helps officers assist someone experiencing a mental health or substance use-related crisis. Topics include risk factors and warning signs for mental health, addiction concerns, and strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations, and where to refer people for help in your community. It is one of the best classes you'll ever take!

Mental Health First Aid provides officers or agency personnel with alternatives to use of force, and appropriate strategies to communicate safely with persons in crisis. A Training Workbook is provided in class.

Topics Covered Include:

- De-Escalation Methods to use
- Depression and mood disorders
- Anxiety disorders
- Trauma, Psychosis
- Substance use disorders
- Autism

Interventions Learned for

- Panic attacks
- Suicidal thoughts or behaviors, Non-suicidal self-injury
- Acute psychosis (e.g., hallucinations or delusions)
- Overdose or withdrawal from alcohol or drug use
- Reaction to a traumatic event
