Salary Incentive or Mandatory Retraining

This 40 Hour CJSTC Course is required by Florida Statute 316 for an officer to issue citations for motorists exceeding the speed limit, while the officer is using a speed measurement device.

Topics: Laser and Radar speed measurement theory, equipment operation, calibration, courtroom testimony, speed offenses, speed estimation techniques, stationary and moving speed measurement techniques, and practical field exercises. Students are required to pass a written exam at 80% and all practical speed measurement activities.

Students must bring and wear during field exercises a DOT approved reflective vest.

The student must have an agency patrol vehicle

REQUIRED:
