For financial aid students, if your Anticipated Aid is not enough to cover your full tuition balance, you must pay the difference by your due date or your classes will be dropped for non-payment. **Having a partial aid award will no longer hold your classes.** If you have a partial award such as Bright Futures, Florida Prepaid, external scholarships, third party sponsorships, or waivers and you have a remaining balance due after these awards are applied you must pay the remaining balance by your due date or your classes will be dropped for nonpayment.

You may pay your tuition and fees by cash, check, debit card, VISA, Mastercard, DiscoverCard, or American Express. Online payment processing is available through the My.DaytonaState.edu portal. Once you have logged in to the portal, click on the My Finances tab and then choose Make a Payment from the dropdown menu. Enter the amount of your payment in the Payment Amount Column and click Next. Complete the appropriate payment information as prompted.

If you have submitted a valid FAFSA and ALL required documents prior to your bill due date you will have your bill automatically deferred. This will be indicated by a FDF hold. If you have not submitted a valid FAFSA and/or have not completed your To Do List prior to your bill due date you must make payment by the bill due date to avoid cancellation of your classes. If you have an approved award but the Anticipated Aid is not sufficient to cover all the charges you must pay the remaining balance by the due date to avoid cancellation of classes. **Students must be enrolled in all classes by the census date. Any class(es) added after the census date will not qualify for financial aid.**

The College has partnered with Nelnet Business Solutions to provide the e-Cashier Payment Plan to assist with paying tuition. To enroll, log in to the My.DaytonaState.edu portal and click on the My Finances tab and then choose Enroll in Payment Plan from the dropdown menu. On the Account Summary page, click on the Make a Payment link to be connected to the Nelnet site to complete your plan agreement. Payments are made by automatic ACH transfers or by automatic credit card payments. No interest is charged but there is an enrollment fee of up to \$40 per semester.
