




# Daytona State College Policy Manual

The College is responsible for providing a safe, healthy and productive learning environment for students, employees and visitors, and the learning environment includes the preparation of students for personal, professional and employer environments. The College prohibits smoking on any campus or property owned or operated by the College. Smoking is defined as smoking or using any tobacco or any type of material in any form, in any equipment, and in any object or device intending to simulate such use, including but not limited to, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, pipes, and vaping devices. The prohibition does not include the use of tobacco products in an individual's personal vehicle on College property. The prohibition includes all College employees, students, and persons on College property. The President may adopt procedures to implement the Tobacco and Smoke Free Campuses policy.
